**The Print Center Receives \$30,000 Award
From The Forman Family Fund of The Philadelphia Foundation**
Funding the Artists-In-Schools Program

PHILADELPHIA, PA (November 5, 2015)—The Print Center has received a \$30,000 grant from The Nessa Forman, David Forman, Eleanor and Solomon Forman Family Fund of The Philadelphia Foundation to support its Artists-In-Schools Program. Announcement of the grant was made by Pedro A. Ramos, President and CEO of the Foundation.

Elizabeth Spungen, Executive Director of The Print Center said, “These funds will be used to provide much needed arts education to underserved Philadelphia public high school students. The award will allow us expand our program to serve a substantially larger number of students.”

Since 2002 The Print Center’s Artists-In-Schools Program (AISP) has provided thousands of Philadelphia high school students with high quality arts education as part of the organization’s ongoing commitment to community engagement. AISP offers hands-on coursework in printmaking and photography, as well as lessons in art appreciation, history and theory in year-long classroom residencies and shorter after-school programs. The award from The Philadelphia Foundation will support a transformative expansion of this nationally recognized program.

The Print Center, a non-profit gallery located in Philadelphia’s historic Rittenhouse Square neighborhood, celebrates a century of encouraging the growth and understanding of photography and printmaking as vital contemporary arts through exhibitions, publications and educational programs.
