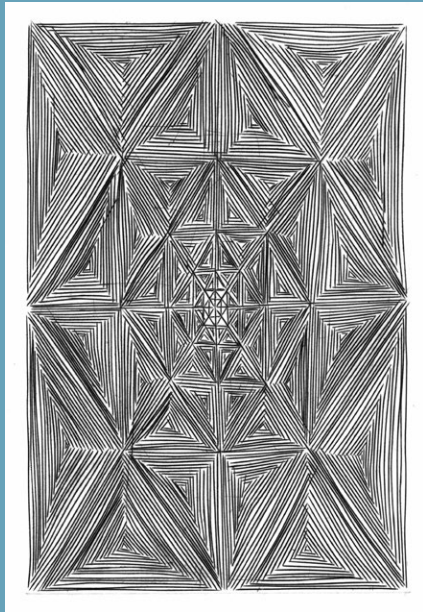

James Siena (b. 1957, Oceanside, CA) is a New York-based artist who is well-known for his labyrinthine and often colorful prints, paintings, drawings and sculptures. He holds a BFA from Cornell University, Ithaca. Siena has had numerous solo exhibitions, including at the Herbert F. Johnson Museum of Art, Cornell University; Dieu Donn , The Museum of Modern Art and Pace Gallery, all New York; and Greg Kucera Gallery, Seattle. His work has been in group exhibitions at venues, such as the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston; Milwaukee Art Museum; American Academy of Arts and Letters, The Drawing Center and The Morgan Library and Museum, all New York; Locks Gallery, Philadelphia; and Delaware Art Museum, Wilmington as well as in Beijing, Dublin and Montr al. His work is in prestigious collections, including the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; The Metropolitan Museum of Art, The Museum of Modern Art and Whitney Museum of American Art, all New York; and San Francisco Museum of Modern Art. Siena teaches at the School of Visual Arts in New York and is a member of the Corporation of Yaddo as well as the National Academy of Design. He is represented by Pace Gallery, New York.
