



## The Print Center receives \$1 million gift

The Print Center announces a \$1 million gift from long-time supporter Julie Jensen Bryan, the largest donation in the organisation's 110-year history. Distributed over five years, the contribution will establish an Endowment Fund, support the care of its late 19<sup>th</sup>-century building.

In recognition of the gift, the institution's historic home will be named "The Print Center at the Julie Jensen Bryan building."

A Philadelphian philanthropist and photographer, Bryan has been engaged with The Print Center for four decades. With her late husband Robert Bryan (1934-2025), she previously gifted the institution \$500,000 in 2010 and contributed to publications, fundraising events and activities across the organisation.

Created in 1915 and based since 1917 at 1614 Latimer Street, The Print Center promotes photography and printmaking through exhibitions, publications and education, including one of the country's oldest annual art competitions, the Artists-in-schools programme for Philadelphia public high schools.
